



**Robert Castor's** Motion for Summary Judgment was affirmed by the 10th District Court of Appeals, in a case in which Bob argued that our client was entitled to enforce a personal guaranty by the owner of a home building company for purchases made on credit over several years. The Court agreed with Bob's argument that the owner's personal guaranty was continuing in nature unless affirmatively revoked, and that, since this owner never revoked the guaranty, he remained personally liable for the unpaid purchases of his company, not just for the original order of materials when he signed the guaranty.
